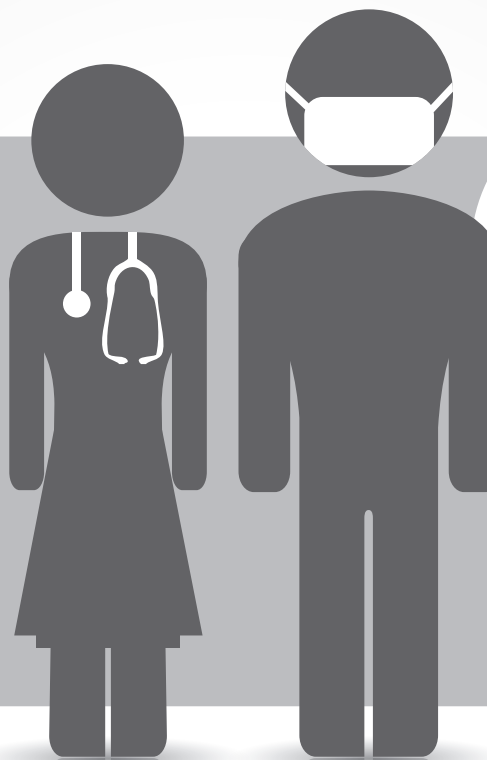

32 Killed

-  23 in Syria
-  6 in CAR
-  2 in South Sudan
-  1 in Pakistan

- 65% of fatalities were due to explosive weapons in Syria.
- Unidentified perpetrators fatally attacked 6 health workers in Gambo Health Center, CAR.



4 Injured

-  2 in South Sudan
-  1 in DRC
-  1 in Egypt

- Select healthcare services were suspended at Karak Government Hospital, Egypt, after a nurse was physically assaulted.
- In Egypt, it was reported that family members of patients accounted for 71% of assaults against health workers.

9 Assaulted

-  7 in Egypt
-  1 in DRC
-  1 in Jordan

- Some healthcare services at Karak Government Hospital, Egypt, were temporarily suspended following the physical assault of a nurse.
- 71% of health worker assaults in Egypt were reportedly perpetrated by relatives of patients.

1 Kidnapped

-  1 in Libya

- In Libya, one health worker was reportedly kidnapped by unidentified assailants and released 3 days later.
